Where to begin? Poor editing, grammar, syntax, character development to name a few. The island communities of Maine, witches everywhere (if you are a believer), law enforcement, as well as the historical society of Salem should all be aghast at the hack job this series presents of them. As well as any reader who enjoys or expects a halfway decent read. I kept expecting each subsequent book to, at least, be a better read than the previous book; however each book contained many of the same problems. Ms Watts' lack of character development never improved, nor did her portrayal of law enforcement procedures. Since when is a suspect "guilty until proven innocent" by the evidence? Nor did her verbage improve....years of age.....blowing out her/his cheeks and too many other repeated phrases that in many years of living in New England (including Maine island living), I have never heard spoken. In closing, this series could have been a much better read had the author had a better understanding of the writing craft

You'll enjoy it.

I am a huge fan of this series but I was so disappointed in the ending. I hope this is only a temporary situation and Jane will realize some things are worth fighting for. One of the things I love about Emma Watts' books are that her characters especially the women have such a strong personality. They give the readers a want to have that sense of self worth and no BS tolerance.

I have read all of the books in the series and while I enjoy them, I don't always like how police are portrayed. There are multiple instances in which the author has said they do things wrong, don't care about protocol and kind of implies they are dumb. Additionally, it could be a regional NE thing, but some of the phrasing seems more British than US so it's odd. It could just be that I am from the SW and don't know some NE Terminology.

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
