

I passed my CRCE, and this was the only guide I used. Upon completing my examination I was quite worried, as I didn't feel confident in the slightest. I read thereafter that some examinations are

weighted differently than others. For individuals wishing to feel absolutely confident, make sure to check out guides in addition to this one. I felt this guide didn't have as much medical information as is perhaps needed, but as I am just one person taking one form of the exam, I cannot be certain it's a fair judgment to make on the quality of this guide.

I found this book very helpful. I took the exam in July and my exam was weighted heavily with questions on professional issues, job placement and development and ethics. I had spoken to two students that took it a few months before me and they said their exams were heavily weighted with questions on the medical aspects of disability. The students I spoke with a year earlier about the exam said it was heavily weighted on counseling theories and techniques. Just wanted everyone to know that it varies as to content. Some of the questions were easy to understand and others I did not have a clue because I am new to the field. I took the online test on the CRCC website and did very well. I am hoping that I got more right than wrong. Still waiting for my results to be mailed to me. (They do not give out results over the phone). I also found the exam long and was tired towards the end. Anyways, I recommend this book to anyone who wants to prepare for this exam.

The only book I studied, in addition to a few online question banks, and I passed the test on the first try. I even passed the book along to colleague who is studying now and she is getting use out of it too. Is it perfect, 100%? No, but no study guide is a perfect stand alone. This is a great basis though.

I literally just took the CRC yesterday and I have to say there were numerous questions that seemed to come straight from this book. It is a wonderful summary version of the test info. Well worth the money. And yes, I did pass!!!

I just took the CRC exam a few days ago and this book allowed me to be more than prepared (I passed). It is broken down into chapters and then has 2 example tests at the end of each chapter. The practice tests are multiple choice with 4 possible answers, exactly like the actual CRC Exam. One test just shows the correct answer and the second test shows the correct answer along with an explanation. In addition to going through this book, and then taking all the practice tests a second time, I paid for the CRC/Prometric approved 50 question practice test, which was WAY easier than the questions in the book. Between these two study methods, I felt very ready for the test. And my exact method was to read at least 10 pages/day, starting 30 days prior to the exam. This method gives you time to go through the whole book (approx. 220 pages) and then have some extra days left over to study however you like. I would recommend this to anyone taking the CRC Exam.
