

I received an ARC in exchange for a review of this book. I've read some of the other Tiffany Black novels previously though. And while I don't think you have to have read the previous installments in this series as far as the plot goes, it would be helpful if you want to understand the characters and their relationships with each other better. The copy I got was mostly technically well-written and flub-free. There were only a few errors I noticed, right near the end. The most amusing of which was

the wedding reception full of 8 year olds instead of the octogenarians I presume were supposed to be the guests. This book was...okay. It seemed more relationship-focused than mystery-focused and the mystery solving process seemed very Stephanie Plum-esque, minus anything particularly funny happening. There wasn't anything that really irritated me about the book or the plot, but there wasn't anything that grabbed me or that I found particularly memorable either. At least it didn't end in a cliffhanger.

The Tiffany Black books are always a pleasant way to pass the time. I love the characters and the way they have developed (despite some reviewers' insistence on comparing them with the Stephanie Plum characters). This one ends with a bit of a twist and I am curious how Tiffany's life is going to unfold in the next installment since two (or three?) of the characters have now apparently departed. What's next, A R Winters?

A R Winters writes a wonderful series. Since I live in Las Vegas I love that it is done here in Vegas. Her characters are really multi faceted and the story line is great. I found this to be a can't put down book which is what I love to read. Happy to see that I do not have a long wait for the next adventure. Thank You A R Winters for the wonderful series.

Inconsistencies are popping up. I know nobody cares if the cat had a different name in book one and book four. But I care. There are a few inconsistencies. It says to me the author just wants to churn them out. I will finish the series but I doubt I will recommend them.

After finishing the third book, I couldn't wait for this one, and I was pleasantly surprised to receive an email from A R Winters stating that it was being released. I loved this book and couldn't put it down, however I did make myself spread it out over 3 or 4 nights before finishing it. It definitely has its funny points and I enjoy reading about the different lifestyles associated with living in Vegas. I'll say that I wasn't too impressed with the ending and how it all came together. I guess I was hoping for something a little more interesting and dramatic, but it is a casual read and not a serious crime novel, of course. I highly recommend giving this novel a read. It was very enjoyable.

This is the third Tiffany Black story I've read. I think I missed the one just previous to Lost Kitten in Las Vegas. However, that did not affect my enjoyment of this quick, fun read. It was well written with only a few minor errors in my Kindle copy. Once again, Tiffany comes across a dead body and ends up solving the case. Like a previous reviewer, I do think there was a bit more importance placed on relationships in this book than on the actual case Tiffany was working on. That did not bother me. This is easy reading and a pleasant story. Although there is not a cliff hanger per se, the reader is left wondering what is happening with the character Stone at the end of the story. No doubt this was by the author's design but as the reader, I was "rooting for" Stone and Tiffany to get together.

Another fun read from the Tiffany Black series. Tiffany and her neighbor/would-be partner Ian stumble over a dead man but succeed in finding out who killed him. I wasn't sure who the killer was until the end, but it made sense. This one elaborated on some of the secondary characters and even had a major change for her grandmother. I also appreciate the insider look at Las Vegas casinos. Hopefully, we'll learn more about Ian in upcoming books. I love these books because they're well written but can be read in one sitting.
