

As a writer, I am always open to words of wisdom from other novelists, and that is how this book

should be viewed: Helpful information shared by writers who have been there, done that. You understand the rules, but you get so mired in the little details of manuscripts, deadlines, and line-edits that stepping back and allowing someone else to share their process can be so enlightening.
