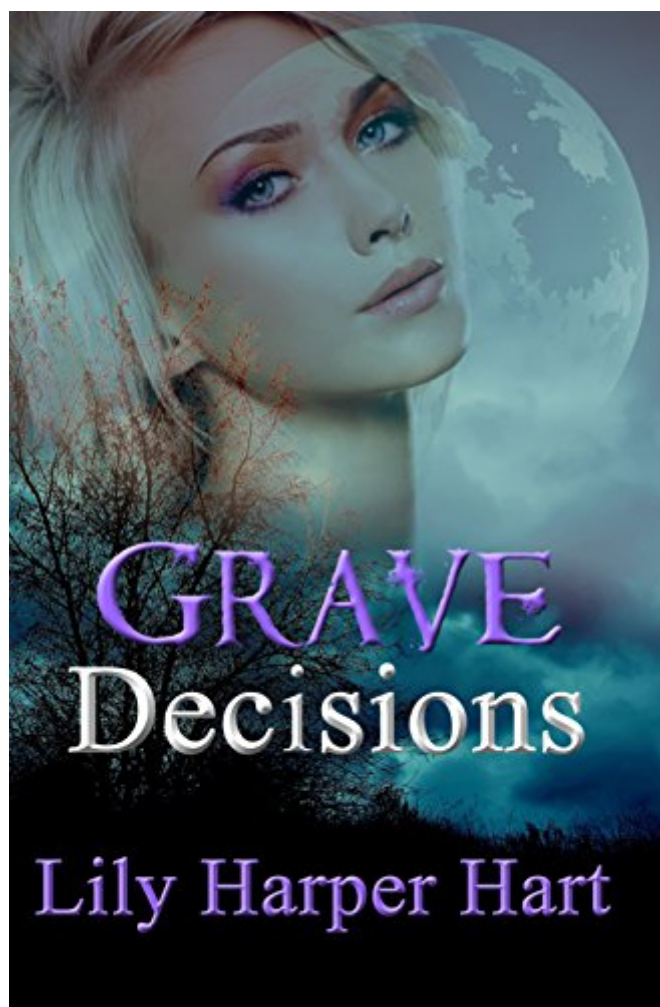


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Grave Decisions (A Maddie Graves Mystery Book 7)



Synopsis

For his part, Ashton seems to enjoy the attention – both positive and negative – even as he fixes his attention on Maddie. Christy is one of the women fawning over Ashton, and when a body is found at one of Blackstone Bay's festival attractions Nick has more suspects than he can wrangle. Death is stalking Blackstone Bay – and Maddie in particular. While Ashton makes a big show about solving the murder, Maddie is the one putting in the work. When the killer sets his sights on Maddie, things spiral out of control – again. Can Nick save Halloween and give Maddie the day she deserves, or will death stalk them both into oblivion?

I keep reading these because I like the idea and the paranormal aspects of the stories. The good friends and family are staples of a good cozy. What I don't like is the main character. While she seems to be getting better she is still entirely too needy and child like. Her relationship with Nick is simplistic and not very believable. I keep reading because I feel the potential is there and the story is decent. I just don't know how much more of clingy Maddie and love struck Nick I can take.

This isn't my favorite Maddie book, but it was definitely a good one! As usual, Maddie and Nick are doing their almost grotesquely cute thing. I really enjoyed that in this book it was Maddie having to fend off an over amorous admirer rather than Nick! Ashton is a total skeazeball and really kept me guessing on whether or not he was the murderer => I thought that the mystery in this one was particularly well done! I also like that, while Maddie is still often insecure or not very good at standing up for herself, that she manages to do so on occasion in this book despite the fact that one of her main supports - Christy - doesn't have her back for once. I was pretty disappointed by Christy's behavior, I felt like it was REALLY out of character and almost like it was just thrown in there for extra drama. Same thing with Cassidy actually. That's why no 5 stars from me. Like, even if Christy was going to pursue Ashton, I felt like she could have done so and had plenty of believable drama without throwing in the extra drama with the way she behaved towards Maddie. Other than that, I found it to be a really enjoyable addition to the series. The murder mystery was great and completely had me guessing and then second guessing myself. Watching Nick trying not to implode due to over-protectiveness, Maddie brushing off the idiots, Maude's antics, etc. was all what I love about these books. I'm really looking forward to the next installment with more of Nick's brother and

Christy (now that she's come back to her senses).

Nick and Maddie are going to the Halloween festival in full costume. Maddie reads tarot cards for fun. A special guest is visiting from the big city who is a renowned psychic. He immediately attracts all the single females in town but really starts to come on to Maddie once he meets her. A couple of murders occur pointing to the psychic. Maddie finds herself in a predicament when her best friend Christy is one of the female's following Ashton Cooper the psychic. The story takes a turn as to the guilty party. A good read. I love the NICK and Maddie saga.

Just loved it! Nick and Maddie's relationship is just perfect and doesn't feel stale. I loved that Maddie is continuing to find herself and be more assertive. Christy is great (although I questioned her judgement in this book!) and hope to see her and John get together. I also like how the ghost elements are progressing, especially with Olivia! The mystery was excellent as always. Can't wait for book 8!

I enjoyed this series. The mushy-ness between the two main characters is a bit much but the mystery aspect ultimately won me over. I did, however, notice many grammatical mistakes and other errors in the book throughout...how is that not caught when edited? Either way I'm giving 4 stars. Although, while I love how mushy and schmaltsy Nick and Maddie can be, it would be nice if so much of the books weren't taken up by those conversations. A little overkill but to each their own.
